

**VILLAGE OF BABYLON  
LOCAL LAW 5 of 2019**

**AMENDMENT TO THE VILLAGE CODE  
CHAPTER 343 VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC**

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of Babylon as follows:

Chapter 343 Article I General Provisions of the Code of the Village of Babylon is hereby amended to have Section 343-3A and Section 343-3B to read as follows:

**A. Uninspected vehicle**

No motor vehicle shall be parked upon any street, road or highway or other public areas of the Village unless a valid certificate of inspection is affixed to the windshield as required by the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York. Any violation of this section shall constitute a parking violation. In such event the registered owner of such vehicle shall be deemed the violator.

**B. Unregistered vehicle**

No motor vehicle shall be parked upon any street, road or highway or other public areas of the Village unless a valid registration sticker is affixed to the windshield together with proper plates on the vehicle as required by the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York. Any violation of this section shall constitute a parking violation. In such event the registered owner of such vehicle shall be deemed the violator.

**Validity.**

If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this law is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this law.

**Effective Date.**

This law shall become effective upon filing in the office of the Secretary of State.
