LOCAL LAW 8 of 2019

AMENDMENT TO THE VILLAGE CODE

CHAPTER 153 FENCES AND HEDGES

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of Babylon as follows:

Chapter 153 Fences and Hedges of the Code of the Village of Babylon is hereby amended by deleting §153-1(A)(3) and §153-1(C) and replacing them with the following:

Fences and Hedges

§153-1. General regulations.

Legislative Intent

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Babylon hereby finds that in order to promote safety and public order within the Village, fences and hedges must be regulated. The Board of Trustees finds that this new section is reasonably aimed at achieving this and that public health, welfare, and good order and the governance of the Village will be enhanced by enactment of the regulation set forth in this section.

§ 153-1 General regulations.

§ 153-1 (A)(3)

“On a corner lot, within the triangular area bounded by the lot lines connecting at the street corner of the lot and a point 30 feet from that intersection on each of said connecting lot lines, solid fencing, which might tend to cause a vision obstruction, may be erected not exceeding three feet in height.”

§ 153-1 (C)

“The provisions of A-3 and A-4 shall also apply to hedges and/or densely growing shrubbery.”
