

The Assessment Roll of the Village of Babylon, Town of Babylon, Suffolk County, New York, upon which the assessment and tax appear was completed on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of March, 2019.

**Taxes become a Lien June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019.**

**Taxes are due in full June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019.** The last date taxes are payable without penalty is July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019. After that date, five per centum will be added for the first month and an additional per centum pursuant to the Real Property Tax Law for each month or fraction thereof thereafter until paid. Additional fees will also accrue as of September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019.

**Credit Card payments** will incur a servicing company convenience fee as follows:

payments up to \$113 will be charged an additional \$3.00 fee

payments over \$113 will be charged an additional 2.65% fee

**Electronic Check Payments** will incur a servicing company convenience fee of \$1.50

pursuant to Real Property Tax Law\*\*\***

**Senior Citizens** may be eligible for a tax exemption. You may also designate a third party to receive a copy of your Tax Bill. The maximum annual income (Social Security, pensions, interest, dividends, etc.) to qualify for Senior Citizen Exemption is currently \$30,000.

**Veterans** may also be eligible for a tax exemption. Contact the Village Clerk's Office for information.

Applications for Senior Citizen Exemptions and Veterans Exemptions are available on our website ([villageofbabylonny.gov](http://villageofbabylonny.gov)) or call 631-669-1500. Applications must be filed by December 30<sup>th</sup> for exemption to be applied to **next year's taxes**, however, we suggest submitting early in November so we can check for all the required documents.

If you feel your **assessment** is too high, you have the right to seek a reduction. Contact the Assessor's Office for information regarding filing a grievance.

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** the Final Tax Roll and Warrant for the Village of Babylon has been completed for the 2019-2020 tax year. Taxes become due on June 1, 2019, and are payable without penalty until July 1, 2019.

Payments are to be made Monday through Friday, 9am-5pm, except holidays, at the Village Clerk/Tax Receiver's Office, located at 153 West Main Street, Babylon, New York. Payments made by mail must have a U.S. Postal postmark by July 1, 2019; Postage meter not accepted. Payments may also be made online via our website ([www.villageofbabylonny.gov](http://www.villageofbabylonny.gov)) by check or credit card. Please note: credit card payments will incur a credit card vendor fee; charged amounts of approx. \$113.00 or less, will have a \$3.00 fee; charged amounts above \$113.00 will incur a fee of 2.65% (subject to change in the near future). Electronic check payments will incur a fee of \$1.50.

Payments received after July 1, 2019 will accrue a 5% penalty immediately, pursuant to Real Property Tax Law Section 1432. Taxes received after July 31 will accrue an additional 1% penalty monthly thereafter until paid. State fee will be added as of September 4, 2019. The Village of Babylon may not accept payment of less than the full amount of taxes and interest due. The collecting officer must collect accrued interest in accordance with Real Property Law Section 1432 when delinquent taxes are paid.
