## **SUMMER RECREATION PROGRAMS 2025**

Trustee Frank Seibert is pleased to announce that the Village's free recreation programs for resident children will run for 5 weeks beginning on the dates listed below. Program registration will open Thursday, May 1, 2025 and close on Saturday, May 31, 2025. **BASKETBALL:** Starts Monday, June 30<sup>th</sup> – Participants must be between 5-12 years of age – Sessions will be held in the High School East Gym from 8:00am-12:00pm. Children in this program will learn and/or improve on basketball skills, drills, and the game.

**GYMNASTICS**: Starts Tuesday, July 1<sup>st</sup> – Participants must be between 5-12 years of age – Sessions will be held at the High School West Gym from 8:00am-12:00pm on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays for ages 8-12 and on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 10:00am-12:00pm for ages 5-7. Children in this program will learn all the basics of gymnastics and how to properly use the gymnastic equipment. The Village Gymnastics Show will be on Thursday, July 31<sup>st</sup> - details to follow.

<u>ARTS & CRAFTS</u>: Starts Monday, June  $30^{th}$  – Participants must be between 5-12 years of age – Sessions will be held in the Grade School on Park Avenue from 8:00am-12:00pm. Classroom to be announced. This program allows students to explore their creative side. Our Art Show will be held in Village Hall on Tuesday, August  $5^{th}$  – details to follow.

<u>TENNIS</u>: Starts Monday, June 30<sup>th</sup>—Participants must be between 9-15 years of age — Sessions will be held on the tennis courts at Babylon Grade School on Park Avenue from 8:00am-12:00pm. Children in this program will learn basic tennis skills, how to play the game and scoring.

<u>THEATRE</u>: Starts Monday, June 30<sup>th</sup> – Participants must be between 7-12 years of age – Session will be held in the Grade School Cafeteria stage area from 9:00am-11:00am. Participants in this program will enjoy being part of a performance, whether it be through acting, dancing, or singing! The children will perform in a show on Wednesday, July 30<sup>th</sup> and will have a cast party on Friday, August 1<sup>st</sup>.

<u>CHESS CLUB</u>: Starts Monday, June 30<sup>th</sup> - Participants must be between 9-15 years of age - Sessions will be held on <u>MONDAYS & FRIDAYS ONLY</u> at the Grade School on Park Avenue from 8:00am-12:00pm. Classroom to be announced. This program will allow students to learn the game of chess and play a few friendly games with friends!
