SANITATION CALENDAR

2025



Enclosed please find your 2025 Village of Babylon Sanitation Calendar and other helpful sanitation and recycling related information. Last January we rolled out our new sanitation schedule, receiving positive feedback throughout the year. This new sanitation system is more efficient, less stressful, and more cohesive for our Village residents, while also saving taxpayer money.

Babylon Village residents now have set and specific garbage/rubbish and household trash pickup days, as well as set recycling days, except for holiday weeks where days may alternate. THERE IS NO GARBAGE, RUBBISH, OR RECYCLING COLLECTION ON SATURDAYS, SUNDAYS, OR HOLIDAYS.

Please note, there is no set pick up time for garbage pickup. As per Village Code, all garbage/rubbish must be prepared and ready for pick up at 7am on your scheduled pickup day, see code below:

§ 302-3 Location of materials for collection; time for placement. [Amended 6-10-1986 by L.L. No. 3-1986; 6-22-2004 by L.L. No. 2-2004; 5-28-2024 by L.L. No. 7-2024]

Such refuse, rubbish, trash and other materials as are required to be placed at the curb for collection as set forth in the regulations of the Sanitation Department shall be placed between the curb and the sidewalk or property line not earlier than 6:00 p.m. on the day immediately preceding the day of collection and not later than 7:00 a.m. on the day of collection designated for the particular area, district or street. Except as aforesaid and on the designated day of collection, no refuse, rubbish, trash or other materials shall be placed, kept or maintained at the curb.

We strongly encourage our Village residents to CALL us with any questions or concerns you may have. While social media can be a great tool, a quick phone call gives us the opportunity to answer all your questions quickly, accurately and thoroughly.

IMPORTANT GENERAL PICKUP INFORMATION

- Use only standard 32-gallon pails with lids. No material can be above the top of the can
- The night before, put items at the curb within one foot from the street in front of your home
- Do not store material at the curb.
 Only put out material that will be collected that day.
- Multi-family homes should put all material at one spot per house

- Keep all garbage cans, bags and bundles under 50lbs
- Do not use the blue recycling can for garbage or newspapers
- Make sure your garbage cans are clear of any parked vehicles.
 Make sure your materials are not placed at the side of any vehicle
- If you still have questions about how to properly dispose of your garbage, please call the office at 631-669-4878, we're here to help



REMEMBER:

Please DO NOT place any garbage or material out to the curb for pickup before 6pm the day before the specific collection. Please put only the material to be collected at the curb. Excessive amounts of material may not be picked up. Please follow the enclosed guidelines or call the office with any questions **631-669-4878**.

RECYCLING PICKUP INFORMATION

When this symbol appears on your garbage calendar, we will be picking up glass, metal cans and plastics from your curbside in your blue recycling bin. We will not collect recycling material from any other type of receptacle. Please remember the following:

- RINSE all metal, glass and plastic cans and bottles
- FLATTEN plastic bottles to fit more contents



When this symbol appears on your garbage calendar, we will pickup properly wrapped newspapers from your curbside. Please note the following:

- WRAP newspapers in twine or put them in paper bags
- DO NOT use your recycling can or a garbage pail
- BUNDLE, TIE, & FLATTEN cardboard boxes, magazines, junk mail, and telephone books



METAL PICKUP

The Village Sanitation Department will continue to provide their metal pick-up service on Fridays throughout the year. You MUST call the Sanitation Department at **631-669-4878** by Thursday of the week you wish to schedule your pick-up.



FURNITURE BULK ITEMS

TWO items of furniture will be taken with each garbage pickup. Make sure that garbage and furniture are at the same location on the curb so it is clear to our workers that you wish to dispose of these items. Please remember only 2 items per garbage pickup. Included in the furniture description is the following:

Couch – Mattress - Box Spring – Dresser – Room sized rug (rolled and tied, cut into sections 4' in length and under 50lbs.)

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS FOR PICKUP

The following items are not permitted for general pickup and should be brought to the Town Residential Recycling Center:

- Auto & Boat Parts
- Car Batteries
- Fireworks
- Ammunition
- Gasoline
- Medical Waste (needles)
- Toxic Material
- Pool Chemicals
- Liquid Paints
- 55-gallon Drums
- Concrete, bricks, stone
- Any Commercially Generated Waste

TRASH CANS

Please use only standard 32-gallon pails with lids. No material can be above the top of the can as this helps our Sanitation Department avoid injury.





PIZZA BOXES

Important Note:

Greasy pizza boxes can contaminate other recyclables. Please place them in your regular garbage pickup

CLEAR BAGS

The Village provides large, clear plastic bags for Village residents. They are available for pickup at the Highway and Sanitation Department on Carlston Place **Monday-Friday** between the hours of 8am-4pm.





BLUE RECYCLE CANS

Should your Village issued blue recycling can need to be replaced, they are available for pickup at the Highway and Sanitation Department on Carlston Place Monday-Friday between the hours of 8am-4pm.

LIMITED CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS

Place items at the curb the night before pickup and please follow the instructions below:

- Building material from major renovations cannot be taken
- Lumber must be securely tied in bundles not more than 4 feet in length, less than 50lbs and cannot be over the top of the pail
- Paneling must be in a container or securely tied in bundles no larger than 2 feet x 4 feet and less than 50lbs. Please remove all nails from the boards to avoid injury
- Put glass in a garbage can or securely wrapped in cardboard, marked "glass." Do not put broken glass in cardboard boxes, plastic bags or blue recycling can.
- 4x4 railroad ties will be accepted if they are under 2 feet in length and securely tied in bundles less than 50lbs.



The Village of Babylon will continue to provide SHRED and STOP days to our Village residents. Please check our Village website **www.villageofbabylonny.gov**, our Village Facebook and Instagram pages, as well as our Village Newsletter for more information on these important dates.

SHRED DAY

This program is held twice a year in the Spring and Fall and allows Village of Babylon residents to safely dispose of documents containing sensitive information such as old bills, receipts, bank statements and anything else you need properly and securely shredded. Shred Day is held at the Highway and Sanitation Department building on Carlston Place.



STOP (STOP THROWING OUT POLLUTANTS) DAY

On the designated day each year in the Fall, this program allows residents to bring household hazardous wastes to the Highway and Sanitation Department building on Carlston Place to safely dispose of the following:

Acids – Aerosol Cans – Antifreeze – Automotive fluids/ care products – Bug and rodent killers – Cleaning products – Driveway sealer – Fluorescent bulbs – Freon canisters – Full propane cylinders – Gasoline – Granular fertilizer containing insecticides – Oil paints and stains – Liquid chlorine – Mercury containing products – Pesticides/insecticides – Powdered chlorine – Thinners and reducers – Pool chemicals





RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING CENTER

Please note the Town of Babylon has a Residential Recycling Center located on Field Street off Edison Avenue in West Babylon that is open for drop-off of recyclable materials weekdays from **8:00am-2:30pm**. If you have any questions, you can reach them directly at **631-249-9346** or **631-249-9347**.

Acceptable items for drop-off at the Residential Recycling Center include: plastics, glass, waste oil, car batteries, computer paper, telephone books, rocks, bricks, E-waste/electronics, household batteries, bicycles, junk mail, oil filters, metal/aluminum cans, polystyrene, newspapers, cardboard, concrete (small pieces), four tires with or without rims, propane tanks and used clothing.
